#### **UAACCE HISTORY**

The Utah Association for Adult, Community, and Continuing Education (UAACCE) was officially formulated on October 18, 1988, at the Yarrow Hotel in Park City, Utah. The founding of UAACCE was consummated with the unanimous approval of a new constitution by the assembled participants at the 1988 joint, annual conference of the Utah Community Education Association (UCEA) and the Adult Education Association of Utah (AEAU).

The development of UAACCE, through the unification of UCEA and AEAU, was the result of over two years of discussion and planning between the two organizations. The approval of the new constitution of October 18, 1988 activated several other important organizational steps, including the election of a new Board of Directors, the establishment of a timeline for the transition of leadership, and the combining of the fiscal and legal aspects of UCEA and AEAU.

Zada Haws of Ogden was selected by the membership to be UAACCE's first President and Ronald Riding of Provo was selected to be President-Elect. Jennie Barber of American Fork served as the Past-President during UAACCE's first year. Other Founding Members of the UAACCE Board of Directors included:

The first Ex-Officio members of the UAACCE Board of Directors were Burton Olsen, Brigham Young University; Brent Gubler, Utah State Office of Education; and Teddi Safman, University of Utah. The first meeting of the UAACCE Board of Directors was held on December 13, 1988 at the Utah State Office of Education.

Adult education encompasses the broad field of education and training for adults outside of the traditional college and university degree programs, such as adult high school completion, adult basic education (reading, writing, communication, math, and interpersonal skills), English as a second language, adult refugee education, homeless education, workforce literacy, foreign languages, civic and public affairs, vocation high school credit pursuits, physical activities, home and family living, pre-vocational education, and leadership training. All these areas are considered within the province of Adult Education.

### **Programs**

# **Adult High School Completion (AHSC)**

- Academic achievement is assessed
- Transcripts and past experiences are evaluated
- Offers all levels of mathematics, English, science, reading, writing, social studies, etc.
- Course work leads to a high school diploma

## General Educational Development Preparation (GED)

- Social studies, mathematics, science, English, writing, and reading skills taught
- Test-taking strategies taught
- After successfully completing the GED test, the adult is awarded a GED certificate, which is a certificate of achievement and not a high school diploma

#### **Adult Basic Education (ABE)**

• Teach basic and beginning reading, writing, and computation skills

#### **English Speaking of Other Languages (ESOL)**

• Teach speaking, listening, and community-oriented skills to non-English speaking adults

### **Prison and Institutionalized Education**

- The instructional components include: ABE, ESOL, GED, AHSC
- Literacy and basic skills necessary for participation in vocational programs, employment opportunities, and functional living outside of the institution
- Emphasis on reducing recidivism

#### ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAM INFORMATION (CONT.)

#### **Workforce Literacy**

- Teach basic skills needed by employees and required by employers to establish a trainable force that can take advantage of further job-specific training and advance the productivity of the labor force on individual, industry, state, and national levels
- Instructional components may include: ESOL instruction, communications skill building, interpersonal skills building, ABE, and problem solving
- Assist employers in assessing the basic literacy needs and skills of employees

#### **Family Literacy**

- Focuses on parents and children needing basic education. Teach parents the literacy and basic education skills necessary for functional adult living and for further academic education and vocational training
- Teach parents to help their children increase literacy and basic education skills

#### **Vocational High School Credit**

- Teach adults high school vocational credit courses that lead to employment following the awarding of a high school diploma
- Some of these courses may include: secretarial occupations, office machines, software applications, carpentry, office machines repair, small engine repair, buildings and grounds maintenance, retail sales, custodian, general office clerk, nursing aide, receptionist, security guard.

#### **General Adult Enrichment**

- All core curriculum subjects available
- Courses and subjects are as diverse and varied as the interest and needs of the enrolled participants
- Fully funded by fee and tuition payments

### CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAM INFORMATION

Continuing education provides opportunities for professional learning as well as lifelong enrichment through participation in social and cultural programs. These programs enable people of all ages to enrich their lives and increase their knowledge without disrupting their employment or lifestyle.

Components of continuing education may include courses for training or retraining, as well as degree programs and participation in conferences. Conferences and degree programs may be delivered over telecommunications, thus providing access for more people to participate in continuing education.

### **Programs**

## **Children's Programs**

• Non-credit activities for children and young adults (usually to age 18), held at on-campus and off-campus locations.

## **Correspondence Study**

 Also known as Home Study or Independent Study. Provides students the opportunity to enroll in collegiate level credit and/or non-credit courses, as well as high school credit courses via the mail.

#### **Distance Learning**

• The capability of a Continuing Education Unit to transmit credit and/or non-credit courses or activities via a telecommunications system, such as interactive television (EDNET), computer conferencing, and electronic mail, to clients in locations distant from the main campus.

#### **Graduate Credit Courses**

- On-Campus: Courses for students on a level above a
   Bachelor's Degree, taught on the main campus, and offered for
   credit by the College/University or by the Continuing
   Education Division.
- Off-Campus: Courses for students on a level above a Bachelor's Degree, taught away from the main campus, and

offered for credit, typically by the Continuing Education Division.

#### **Non-Credit Courses**

 Off-Campus: Courses for individuals of any age as defined by the nature of the curriculum and taught on the main campus for no credit.

## **Non-Credit Courses (Cont.)**

 Off-Campus: Courses for individuals of any age as defined by the nature of the curriculum and taught away from the main campus for no credit.

## **Travel Study**

 Credit and/or non-credit courses of study generally offered in more non-traditional teaching/learning environments away from the main campus and usually involving formal travel.

## **Undergraduate Credit Courses**

- On-Campus: Courses provided for students with, or working toward, a Bachelor's Degree, taught on the main campus, and offered for credit by the College/University or by the Continuing Education Division.
- Off-Campus: Courses provided for students with, or working toward, a Bachelor's Degree, taught off the main campus, and offered for credit by the College/University or by the Continuing Education Division.

#### APPLIED TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION PROGRAM INFORMATION

There are nine Applied Technology Centers (ATC) in Utah. They were officially organized under the State Board of Vocational Education and funded by appropriations from the Utah State Legislature in January 1971. Their open-entry/open-exit policy and individualized programs are a progressive educational tool unique to postsecondary institutions which allows a student to start in a program at any particular time and finish when they complete the required material.

Vocational Education offered at ATCs encompasses a tremendous variety of programs designed to equip adults with career and life skills, retrain for new jobs, and keep up with changing technological requirements in the workplace. These centers (through a cooperative effort with local industry, business and government) also provide technical education for high school students, displaced workers, the under-employed, and displaced homemakers.

# **Programs**

## **Certificated Programs**

- Technical/job training in business, health care, industry, and employability skills
- Long term -- take from six months to a year to complete, and are open-entry/open-exit
- Short term -- are from ten to two hundred hours in length
- Proficiency certificates -- give pertinent information on specific skill level achieved in the portion of the program the student completed while enrolled
- Completion certificates -- awarded to students who successfully complete requirements of the program they are enrolled in
