MORNING KEYNOTE: JEFF THREDGOLD

Jeff Thredgold has been helping people understand the tangled maze of the economy and financial markets for over three decades. With a unique ability to “cut through the fluff,” he will lead us on a slightly irreverent, up to-the-minute “tour” of the economy, financial markets, education, government, and a sneak preview of the future. Jeff is President of Thredgold Economic Associates, an economic consulting and professional speaking company. He worked for 23 years as Senior VP and Chief Economist of KeyCorp and now serves as economic consultant to Zions Bancorporation. Jeff was an adjunct professor of finance at the University of Utah for 16 years and served as president of the Utah National Association for Business Economics.



LUNCH KEYNOTE: LT. GOV. GREG BELL

Greg Bell has served as the Lieutenant Governor of Utah since September 1, 2009. Previously he served in the Leadership of the Utah State Senate, as mayor and city councilman of Farmington, and chair of Envision Utah. Lt. Gov. Bell was born and raised in Ogden. He graduated from Ogden High School, Weber State University and the S.J. Quinney College of Law at the University of Utah. He practiced law at the firms of Kirton & McConkie and later at Fabian & Clendenin specializing in real estate law and has had extensive experience with real estate development, land use and finance. Lt. Gov. Bell and his wife, JoLynn, currently reside in Fruit Heights, Utah. They are the parents of six children and 18 grandchildren.
