Dr. Cooper was also a member of the Observer Delegation from the United States to the 1997 UNESCO Conference on Adult Education in Hamburg Germany. He is a founding member and current co president of the National Association for Adults with Special Learning Needs. Most recently, he co-authored a book titled *Test Anxiety, A Student Manual and Teacher's Guide* (2009).
